Famous inventors

Czech inventions: sugar cube, contact lenses, semtex, fingerprints, cell theory, blood type classification, the word „robot“, polarography, arc lamp, lighting wire, propeller and more.

Beer lovers

Czechs consume the most beer per capita worldwide - in 2018 it was 141 liters per capita, while the average Czech man consumes average of 7 beers a week. The very first brewery was established here in 993. Several beer festivals are held here every year.

Famous cosmonauts

The Czechs (specifically Vladimír Remek) were the 3rd nation in space and at the same time the first Europeans in space. A Little mole (a Czech children's animated fairy tale character) also got into space. The first music to be heard on the Moon was the symphony „From the New World“ by Czech composer Antonín Dvořák.

Fat food lovers

National dishes include pork with cabbage and dumplings, fried steak (schnitzel) with potato salad, sirloin in cream and other sauce dishes with dumplings. And best to rinse the dish with beer.

Czechs – nation of musicians

The Czech Republic boasts a unique system of music education, accessible to all, which has no analogues in Europe. The main pillars are Art schools (ZUŠ), which provide basic education in arts - music, dance, art, drama, to children since 5 years of age. Welcome to the region of LAG Šumperský venkov

The territory, in which the LAG Šumperský venkov operates, is located in the Olomouc region, Šumperk district and is delimited by cadastral territories of a total of sixteen municipalities: Bludov, Dlouhomilov, **Dolní Studénky**, Hrabšíň, Libina, Nový Malín, Oskava, Petrov nad Desnou, Sobotín, **Rapotín**, **Loučná nad Desnou**, Rejchartice, **Velké Losiny**, Vernířovice and Víkřovice. One of the common denominators of all LAG member municipalities is the close proximity to the town of Šumperk and the proximity of the Hrubý Jeseník Mountains. The entire Šumperk district is defined by as an “economically weak region”.

The LAG's area of 410.39 km². Forests account for over half of the area. The average altitude of the area is 425 meters above sea level. The highest point is Mravenečník (1,350 meters

above sea level), at the top of which there is one of the highest wind power stations in Europe. Beautiful nature with a unique amount of forests offers high potential in tourism development, which is highlighted by the fact that the area is literally interwoven with many hiking and cycling paths leading to many historical and natural treasures of this region. The significant potential of the area can also be seen in the developing spa industry in the villages of Bludov and Velké Losiny, which makes the region very attractive and frequently visited.

The presence of the unique Velké Losiny Handmade Paper Mill, which, as the name suggests, is engaged in the production of traditional handmade paper, undoubtedly contributes to the popularity with tourists. This is most likely the last paper mill of its kind in Europe. Part of this important building is the unique Museum of Handmade Paper. Among the most attractive tourist sights of the region is also Velké Losiny Castle, sadly famous for witch trials. As far as we know, in the Czech lands witch trials occurred only locally and the area of Jeseník and Velké Losiny was one of such sites. Another nationwide rarity is the Dlouhé Stráně hydroelectric power plant.

Amongst the cultural events of supra-regional importance we can mention the Velké Losiny Cultural Summer theater festival, or the international festival of wind orchestras Music Without Borders held annually in Dolní Studénky. Equally important tourist attractions are the ski resorts in Loučná nad Desnou, Hraběšice and Vernířovice.

About LAG Šumperský venkov

LAG Šumperský venkov was established in 2006. Today it has 51 members composed of representatives of the public, private and non-profit sectors. It unites a region consisting of 16 municipalities with more than 26,000 inhabitants on an area of 410.39 km². Due to its size, it belongs to the slight below average in the Czech Republic.

In the 2007-2013 programming period, the LAG redistributed around EUR 840,000 in its region. These were funded by the Rural Development Program (Ministry of Agriculture). LEADER projects were supported mainly for farmers, small entrepreneurs and craftsmen, forestry, non-profit organizations and municipalities, and cooperation projects between LAGs.

In the current period 2014-2020, the LAG Šumperský venkov had approximately EUR 4 million at its disposal - through 4 operational programs (Integrated Regional Operational Program, Rural Development Program, Operational Program Employment = European Social Fund, Operational program Environment) and Local Action Plans in Education. Investments in agriculture, forestry, rural business and associations and support for leisure and cultural activities from the RDP were again supported. Newly also IROP supported investments for firefighters, schools, transport safety, revitalization of national cultural monuments, social services and social entrepreneurship.

Among soft activities within the OP Employment, suburban camps, community centers, social services, entrepreneurship and employment support activities were supported.

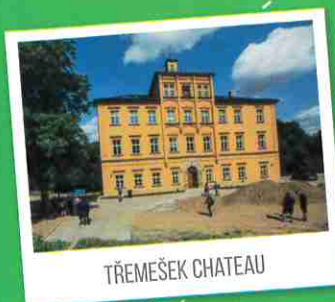

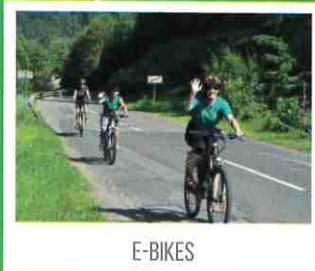

In addition to LEADER, our LAG also implements other projects (these vary across LAGs):

- Local Action Plans in Education in the Šumperk region,
- Support of regional labeling – Jeseníky original product,
- The LAG owns equipment for cultural events (large-capacity tents, stage, sound system, lights, gas heaters, tables and chairs for audience), which the LAG lends to its municipalities.
- LAG working squad – 5 workers lead by a leader help in the region with various tasks
- Patterns for schools and NGOs – simplified reporting of expenses - project days, staff sharing, school assistants, education, etc.
- Coorganization of cultural events in the region
- Projects for youth - ERASMUS+



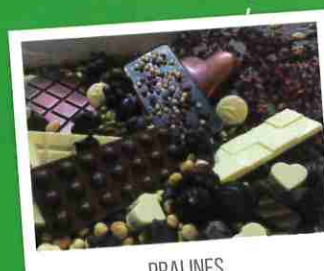

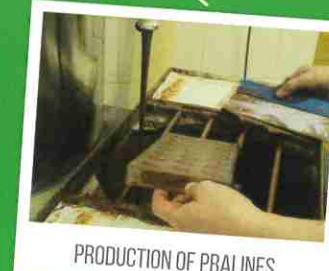

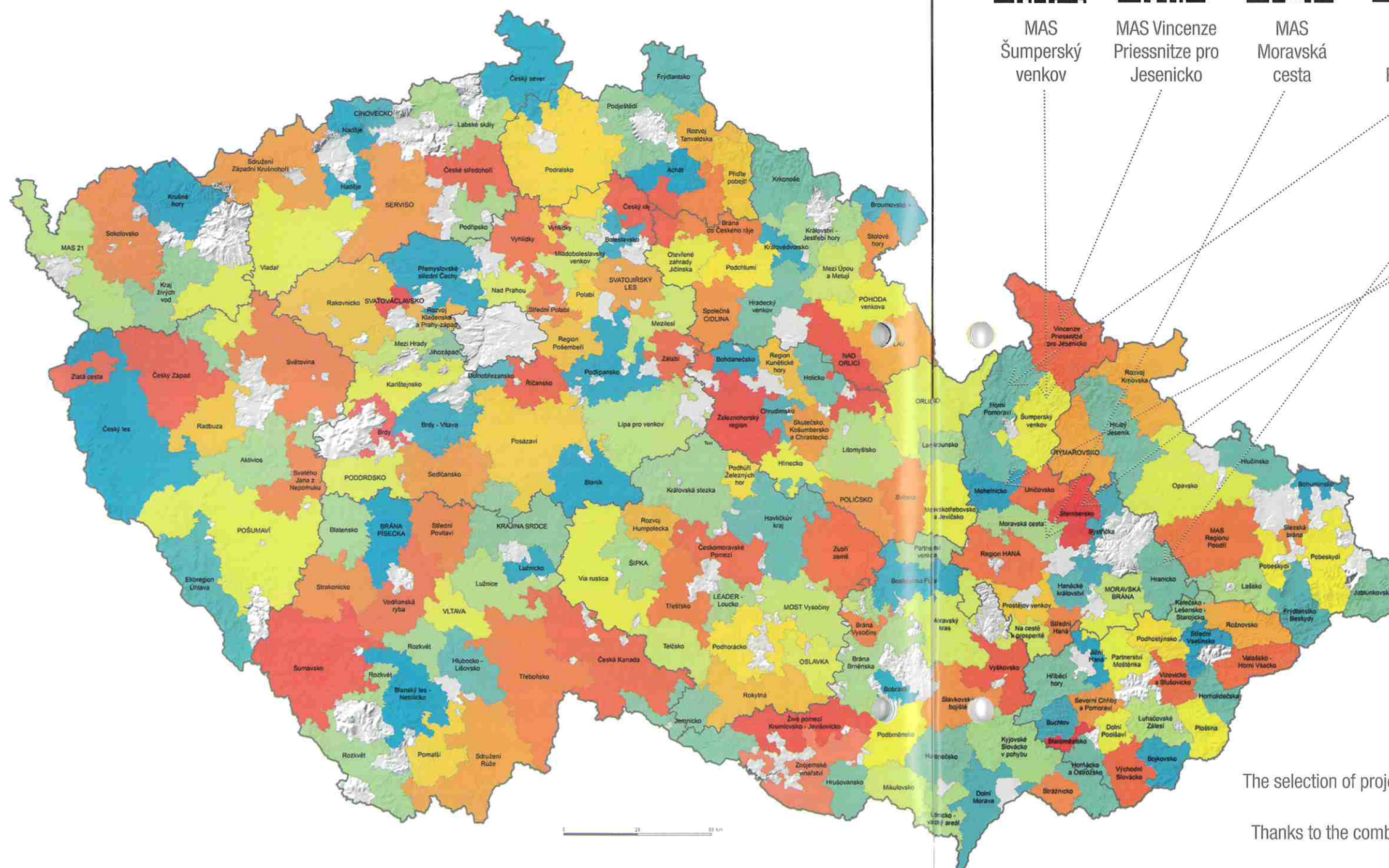

There are 180 LAGs operating in the Czech Republic.

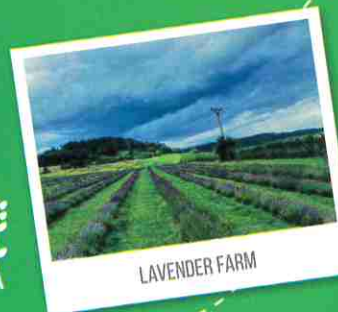
90% of the territory of the Czech Republic

of Local Action Groups of the Czech Republic.

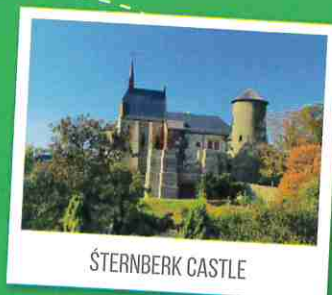
SCLLD is coordinated by the Ministry of Regional
Development, which cooperates with the managing
authorities of other operational programs. The managing
authorities issue grant calls, which are followed by calls from
individual LAGs.

The selection of projects is ensured by the LAG on the basis of predetermined criteria.

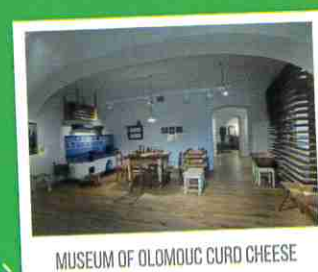
Thanks to the combination of 4 operational programs, LAGs can implement activities
from different areas.



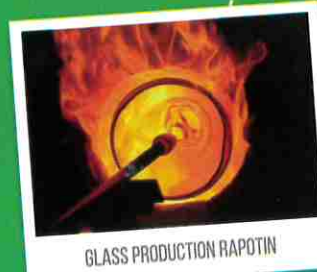

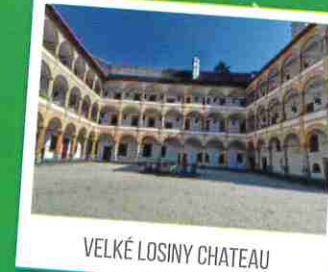

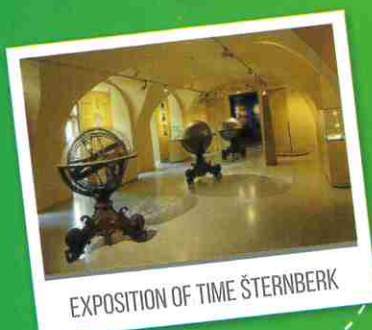


In the 2014-2020 programming period, according to Regulation (EU) No 1303/2013 of the European Parliament and of the Council, the LEADER program is referred to as Community-Led Local Development (CLLD), supported by the EAFRD*, but may also benefit from other funds – ERDF*, ESF* or EMFF*. This is the difference in comparison with the previous programming period, when the LEADER subsidies were drawn exclusively from the EAFRD*. CLLD is implemented through the Common Agricultural Policy and is set up in the Rural Development Program, the Integrated Regional Operational Program, the Operational Program Employment and the Operational Program Environment (LEADER Method, 2015).

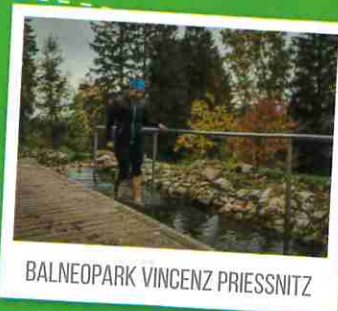
The main objective of using CLLD is according to the Partnership Agreement (2016): “Strengthening the territorial cohesion of rural areas and ensuring long-term sustainable development of the territory by addressing relations between municipalities with peripheral and stabilized typology and rural development centers”. The CLLD is led by the LAGs and is implemented on the basis of integrated and multisectoral local development strategies, taking into account local needs and potential. Development is intended for rural territories, namely LAG territories formed by administrative territorial municipalities with less than 25 000 inhabitants, when the maximum size of the LAG will not exceed the limit of 100 000 inhabitants and will not be less than 10 000 inhabitants (Methodological opinion of MRD, 2015).

Support is coordinated by the ESI Funds and if it is established that a Community-led local development strategy (SCLLD) requires support from more than one Fund, the SCLLD Selection Committee may designate a main cost support fund (European Parliament Regulation 1303/2013).

* EAFRD – European Agricultural Fund for Rural Development; ERDF – European Regional Development Fund; ESF – European Social Fund; EMFF – European Maritime and Fisheries Fund.



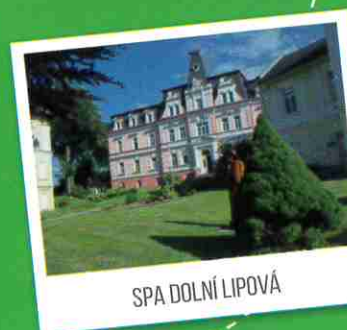

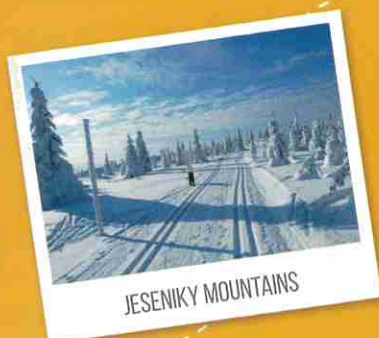

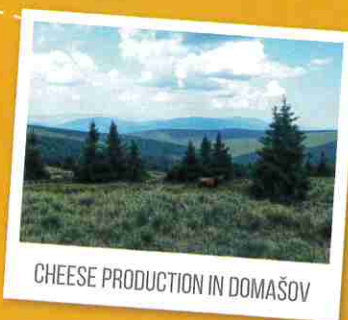

Location of LINC

Loučná nad Desnou

Loučná nad Desnou is a mountain village in the north of the LAG's region. It has a popular sports resort, heavily attended mainly for winter sports and trekking. There is also a unique technical sight – a hydroelectric power plant.



Kouty nad Desnou

Kouty nad Desnou is a local part of Loučná nad Desnou village. It's the main venue of the LINC Conference 2022. It is a popular tourist destination - not only for sports activities, but also cable cars and a unique power plant. Hydroelectric power plant in Loučná nad Desnou is one of the most interesting places in the Czech Republic. The upper tank of the power plant is situated on top of the hill in the height of 1 353 m. The highest point of the Jeseníky Mountains is a mountain called Praděd (1 491 m), which can be seen also from the upper tank of the hydroelectric power plant.

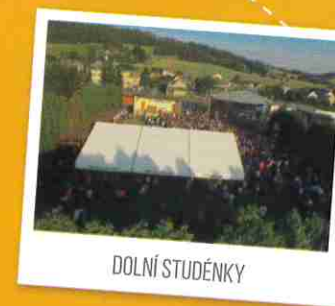

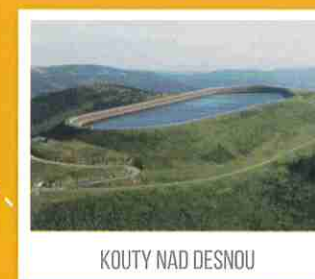

Velké Losiny

Nowadays it is one of the most visited municipalities in the LAG region, especially for Velké Losiny Castle, Velké Losiny Handmade Paper Mill and with the Museum of paper and spa with a thermal water park.



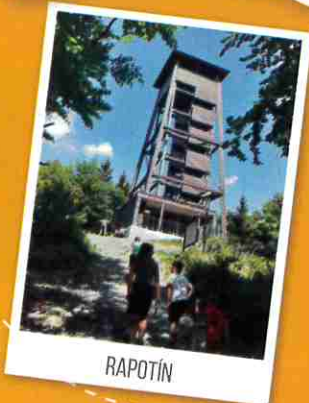
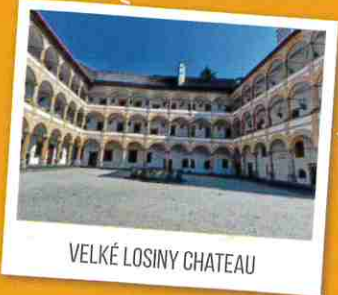
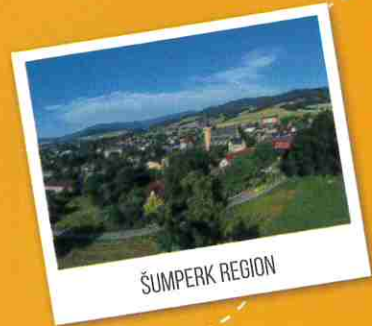
Šumperk

Šumperk is the biggest town and the traditional centre of the region, called „A Gate to the Jeseníky Mountains“. It is nicknamed „Little Vienna“ for its picturesque streets and squares. It is home to the main employers in the region and is one of the largest cities in the northern part of Moravia.



Rapotín

Rapotín is a village of more than 3 200 inhabitants. There is a nice cultural centre. It's also a place, where the main building of the bundle school of the Desná Valley is situated. The bundle school is a unique connection of 3 kindergartens and 3 primary schools under the head of one director, whose seat is in Rapotín.

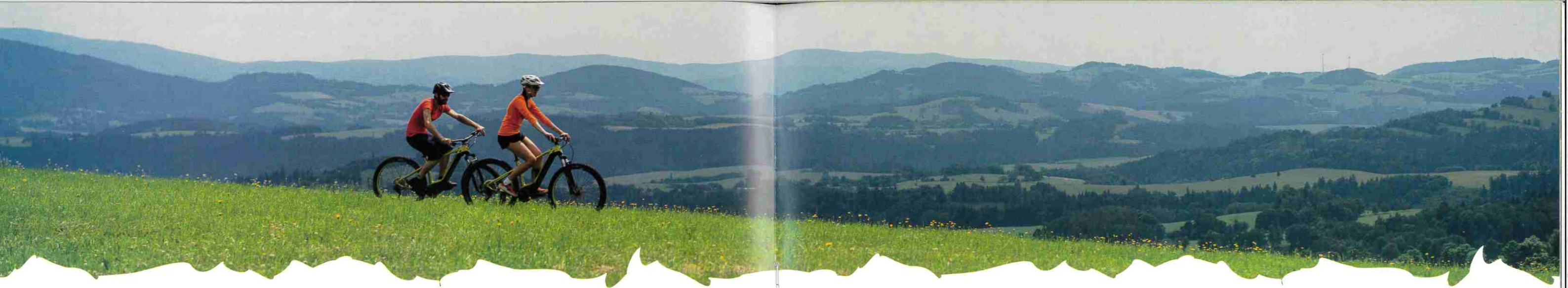

Study tour 3: Business in the countryside and successful regional companies

Organization: LAG Horní Pomoraví

- **Kostka scooters** - production of scooters of the company's own design. Originally produced models only for children, nowadays they produce models as a sports equipment, also for professional riders.
- **PRO-BIO, s.r.o.** - one of the first and largest producer of organic food in Czechia. The company operates 3 mills, a packaging line, several warehouses and can offer over 1,500 organic products and around 40 types of organic seeds.
- **Microbrewery & wellness centre Kolštejn** - brewery brought back a long-extinct tradition of brewing in the village of Branná. It is part of the Kolštejn wellness complex. Beer tasting is available at the restaurant.
- **Branná Farm** – ecological agricultural practices, environmentally friendly and welfare of farmed animals.

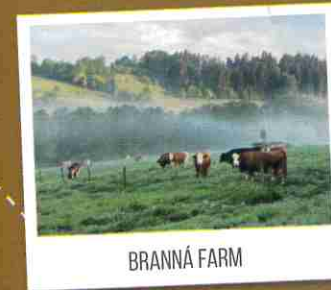

Study tour 4: Regional food products and education

Organization: LAG Horní Pomoraví

- **Severovýchod Primary School and Youth House Krasohled Zábřeh** - Wheelchair accessible school for children from 6-15 years old with a youth house as a part of the school, which provides leisure activities. Possibility to produce a hand made wooden pencils or metal puzzles.
- **Via Delicia, Zábřeh** - cannery, which processes mainly meat, fruits and vegetables – products are handmade according to old methods of production, from local ingredients, and without any preservatives at all. Product tasting and possibility of shopping at a local store.
- **Rovensko Primary school and Nursery school** - small school with a low number of children from 6 - 11 years old (newly renovated from CLLD). Children from several grades are taught in one classroom, by the same teacher. Children learn to work independently, the teacher receives an immediate feedback from the children, and an individual approach is offered. Visit to the renovated premises and short children's performance.
- **Sport a Relax centre Bozeňov** - lunch and sport activities: scooter rides, wall climbing and archery experience. Please note that there is no mobile signal in the Bozeňov area.

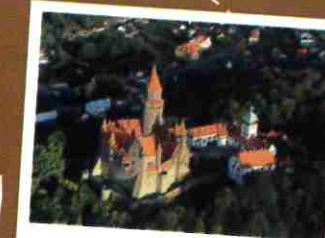

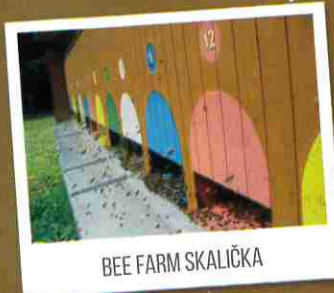


Study tour 10: Let's recognize the region of time, speed and rich history

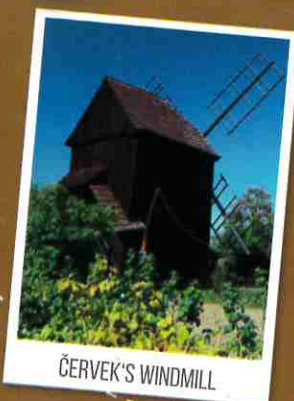

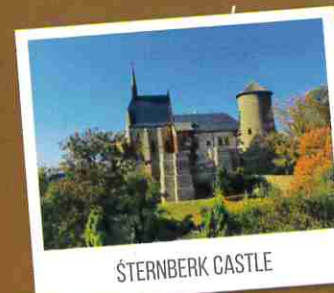

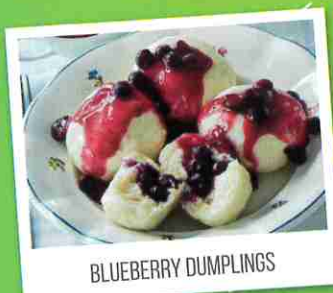
The evening programs of the LINC Conference 2022
